David's Table Trust is a charity based on a Christian ethos.

Why are we called David's Table?

There is a story in the Bible about King David; he showed kindness to Mephibosheth who was disabled and the only relative of Saul.

In 2 Samuel chapter 9 King David asked "**Is there anyone from the house of Saul to whom I may show kindness?**"

He came to live with David and David looked after him – he ate at his table. David made a lifetime commitment to Mephibosheth. This is what we want to do for people with learning difficulties! Hence the name – David's Table Trust.

What will we do?

We plan to provide Christian based Meaningful Occupation sessions: planned, personalised daily activities that will improve the health and spiritual wellbeing of people with a learning difficulty and develop confidence and independence.

Also our aim is to provide supported accommodation and excellence of care within a Christian community.

We want to encourage and support people with disabilities to make their own choices, to continue to learn and work towards fulfilling all the plans and purposes the Lord has for them.

We also seek to work with our partner organisation '**Trowbridge Friends Link**' and provide support and care as well as enrichment activities for people with learning difficulties in the local community.

The support will provide opportunities for people with learning disabilities to:

- Develop their abilities further
- Pursue work and recreational options
- Maximise their quality of life
- Live as independently as possible
- Encourage others and be encouraged in their walk with Jesus.
